This dashboard will help you create integrated app, integration keys, certification, publishing, and merchant management.

The first step is to accept the invitation sent to you via email. This will contain a link to the developer dashboard as well as help you create your password. Please note that typically your user name will be your email address you applied with.

Although there's lots to do and see in there developer dashboard, there are a few things you may want to do first!

1) From the main dashboard, go to API KEYS. Click "create new key" and create your first API keys. API keys is part of the credential you sent within the HTTP Headers, it is a required part of authentication.

You can create multiple API Keys, and as the need arise, you can replace your solution with a new API key if you believe the prior key needed to be recycled out or if ever becomes at risk.
