
This dashboard will help you create integrated app, integration keys, certification, publishing, and merchant management.

Although there's lots to do and see in there developer dashboard, there are a few things you may want to do first!


1) From the main dashboard, go to API KEYS. Click "create new key"and create your first API keys. API keys is part of the credential you sent within the HTTP Headers, it is a required part of authentication.

You can create multiple API Keys, and as the need arise, you can replace your solution with a new API key if you believe the prior key needed to be recycled out or if ever becomes at risk.



Next thing you need to do is create your first app (you can create unlimited apps, but each will have a unique app key)


Simply go to "Apps" and click on "Create new App "




You will need to give you app a name and generate an app key.

your app will be listed in for the Aldelo App Marketplace.




Once you have an app name, you will need to provide some additional information regarding versioning and build numbers.



If you have already been coding and are ready to test and would like to test your app. You can download the Aldelo Express app from the Apple App Store and create a trial store,

When doing so you will have a **SUBSCRIPTION ID** displayed at the bottom of the app. On the login page once you have the subscription ID, you can click "Request test store Association" and our staff will gladly add that test store to your account.
